**March 23, Saturday: Auckland, New Zealand: DEPARTS 05:00 PM**

**March 24, Sunday: Tauranga (Rotorua), New Zealand: 8AM to 5PM** The curved shoreline of the Bay of Plenty—known in Maori as Te Moana-a-Toi—is home to incredible surfing, white-sand beaches and New Zealand's only active marine volcano.

**March 25, Monday: Gisborne, New Zealand: 8AM to 5PM** As the easternmost town in the country, it's the first to see the sun rise, and it was the first place in New Zealand spotted by the British explorer Captain James Cook, in 1769.

**March 26, Tuesday: Napier, New Zealand 8AM to 5PM** Napier has a perfect mix of natural and manmade beauty. The historic district, was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2007. As a delicious bonus, there's a thriving food and wine scene.

**March 27, Wednesday: Wellington, New Zealand 7AM to 7PM** Wellington is known for culture and cuisine. Capital of New Zealand. Has national museum about Maori; go behind the scenes of the Lord of the Rings movies made in Wellywood

**March 28, Thursday: Lyttelton (Christchurch), New Zealand 8AM to 5PM** Christchurch maintains its classic English feel, with lush botanical gardens and Edwardian punting boats cruising along the Avon River.

**March 29, Friday: Port Chalmers (Dunedin), New Zealand 8AM to 6PM** The magnificent Dunedin Railway Station and Larnach Castle have been restored to their full glory, and the fascinating Toitu Otago Settlers Museum provides a glimpse into the lives of early residents. This is the place to take a tour to the Albatross Sanctuary.

**March 30, Saturday: Cruising Fiordland Natl Park** This stunning 12,000-square-kilometer (4,633-square-mile) park encompasses mountains, lakes, fjords and rain forests.

**March 31, Sunday & April 1, Monday: Days at Sea** Enjoy your beautiful ship and watch for the Southern Cross.

**April 2, Tuesday: Hobart, Tasmania, Australia 8AM to 10PM** The little Australian island is home to stunning landscapes, old-growth forests and exceptional local produce.
