
WED., OCT. 12, NORTH CONWAY, NH TO BOURNE MA, B,L

Forefathers.


THUR., OCT. 13TH: GROTON, MA TO MARTHA'S VINEYARD TO MASHANTUCKET, CT

Bridge Skywalk, a new pedestrian walkway where visitors can stroll 600 feet out on the remaining support towers and enjoy the view!

TUES., OCT. 18TH: YOUNGSTOWN, OH TO FLORENCE, KY, B,D

With Halloween 2 weeks away, we stop at the **Anthony-Thomas Candy Co.** for a tour and an opportunity to purchase their delicious candy. They are know for their Ohio Buckeye candy.
